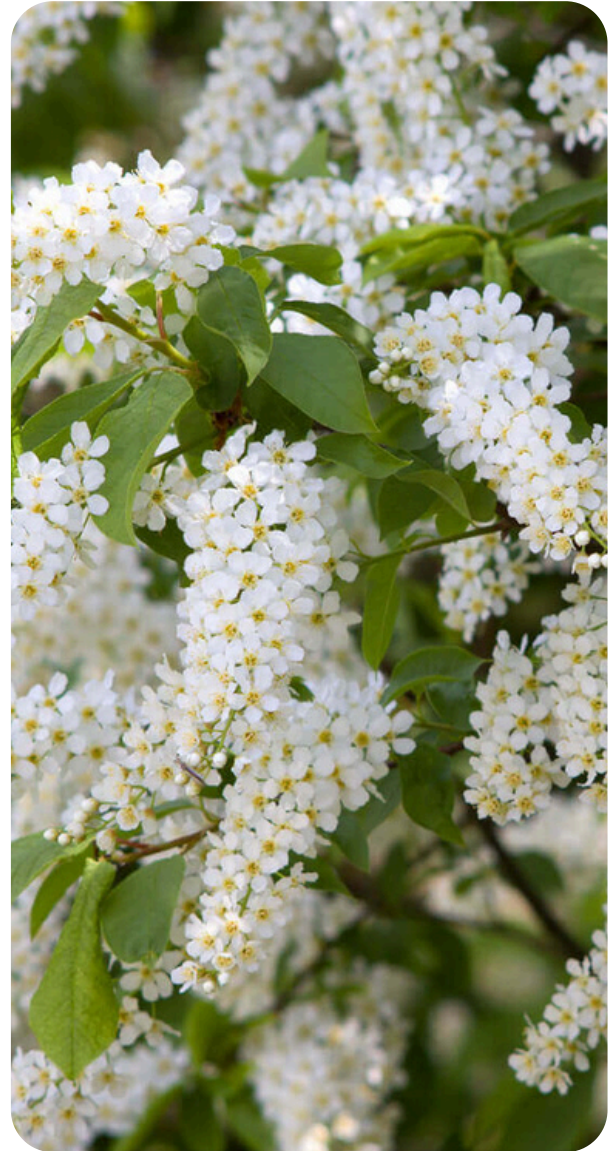

Landowners must act to prevent the spread into natural areas, including:

- Chugach State Park
- Anchorage Coastal Wildlife Refuge
- Chugach National Forest
- Far North Bicentennial Park
- Stream corridors
